antagonist (antaguhnuhst) noun

- 1. The character who opposes the main character in a story.
- 2. The "bad guy or villain.

dialect (diiuhlEHkt) noun

- 1. A form of language used in a certain geographic region; it is distinguised from the standard form of the language by pronunciation.
- 2. how people speak language. Usually it depends on the region they live, culture, or group of people they associate with.

dynamic character A character that changes as the story progresses/

foreshadow (fawrshadoh) the use of clues to suggest events that will happen later in the plot

plot noun, verb

- 1. storyline; has a beginning, a middle, and an end
- 2. the action that makes up the story . EVENTS

protagonist (prohtaguhnuhst) *noun* the main charater in a story, often the good or heroic type

setting (sEHtihNG) noun,adjective the time and place of the action of a literary work

static character Characters that stay the same throughout the story

suspense (suhspEHns) *noun* the excitement or tension a reader feels as they wait for the outcome of the plot

theme (theem) noun

- 1. the lesson the main character learns in a story
- 2. A message or lesson in a story
