

## Vocabulary Week 3

**Alliteration** (uhlihturayshuhn) *noun* Use of the same consonant at the beginning of each word when they are in the same sentence.

**Figurative Language** *Noun* A writing or speech that is not meant to be taken literally. The many types of figurative language are known as figures of speech.

**Literal Language** uses words for the exact meaning- the meaning found in the dictionary

**hyperbole** (hiipurbuhlee) *noun* Extreme exaggeration.

**idiom** (ihdeeuhtm) *noun* It's a saying or use of vocabulary that only a specific group of people understand.

**metaphor** (mEHtuhfawr) *noun* A comparison of two unlike things without using like or as.

**onomatopoeia** *noun* A figure of speech in which words are used to imitate sounds (swish)

**personification** (pursonuhfuhkayshuhn) *noun* Giving human qualities to something that is not human.

**pun** (puhn) *noun, verb* a play on the double meaning of a word.

**simile** *noun* A comparison of two unlike things using like or as.
