Alliteration (uhlihturayshuhn) *noun* Use of the same consonant at the beginning of each word when they are in the same sentence.

Figurative Language Noun A writing or speach that is not meant to be taken literally. The many types of figurative language are known as figures of speech.

Literal Language uses words for the exact meaning- the meaning found in the dictionary

hyperbole (hiipurbuhlee) noun Extreme exaggeration.

idiom (indeeuhm) *noun* It's a saying or use of vocabulary that only a specific group of people understand.

metaphor (mEHtuhfawr) *noun* A comparision of two unlike things without using like or as.

onomatopoeia *noun* A figure of speech in which words are used to imitate sounds (swish)

personification (pursonuhfuhkayshuhn) *noun* Giving human qualities to something that is not human.

pun (puhn) noun, verb a play on the double meaning of a word.

simile noun A comparision of two unlike things using like or as.
